



**ISoP BURSARIES**  
**Training courses**  
**Belgrade, 27 & 28 May 2010**  
**(Faculty of Pharmacy)**

The International Society of Pharmacovigilance (ISoP) can offer some limited financial assistance to **young researchers in pharmacovigilance from emerging countries\*** (maximum age 35 years - from universities or research institutions) and **full-time students from any countries\*\*** (maximum age 30 years) who wish to attend the Belgrade training courses as follows:

**Applications for Bursaries:**

To be eligible for a grant, applicant must be a paid up member of ISoP. Consecutive applications from previous ISoP meetings may be considered but first time applicants will be given priority.

Delegates who may be eligible should apply to the ISoP Administration/Grants Committee by e-mailing [administration@isoponline.org](mailto:administration@isoponline.org) with

- the completed form (Application form)
- a short Curriculum Vitae describing current active work and interest in pharmacovigilance (max 1 page)
- one reference from a supervisor
- documentation of full-time student status

The Application Information form should describe the support needed to cover expenses. If you are requesting travel funding, please check with your travel agent or airlines to find the lowest cost to purchase your ticket. For those who are eligible, reimbursement for approved expenses will be made upon receipt of invoices/travel expenses after the courses (travel or/and hotel reservation must be arranged by the recipient of bursary).

ISoP will ask you to write a short report on your experience at the Belgrade training courses or to disseminate the information you have learnt to a wider audience in your country

**The deadline for applications** is 5 April 2010. If the application with requested documents is not received **by 5 April 2010**, it will not be accepted for consideration by the Grants Committee. The applicant is responsible for confirming that ISoP Administration received the application.

ISoP Administration will inform applicants of the outcome of their application before the 15 April 2010.
