The new EU post-licensing legislation will introduce mandatory elements to pharmacovigilance practice, some of which are very new. They all are of great importance for regulators, scientists and industry. In this advanced course these elements will be elucidated, offering opportunity for open discussions and thoughts on how to fill the remaining empty spaces in good pharmacovigilance practice.
